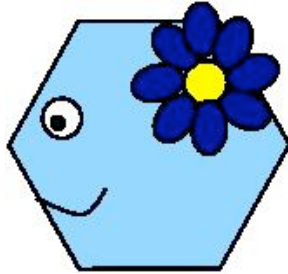


**“MATH: CAN YOU SEE IT?”**

Sonia Kovalevsky was a renowned mathematician, writer, and advocate for women's rights in the 19th century.
